



Hydrilla-A Very Invasive Aquatic Plant

- Native to India and Korea
- First found in FL in 1950
- Grows in waters up to 25' deep
- Saw-toothed leaves; feels rough
- Can grow in low light
- Each stem can grow 1-4 inches per day!
- Displaces native plants
- Interferes with navigation and recreation
